

## HURRICANE PLAN & RELEASE

Brandt Veterinary Clinic encourages pet parents who anticipate a hurricane evacuation, to evacuate as early possible with your pets to a safe area (friend, relative's house, motel, etc.). Pets will need identification (tagged collar and microchip ID are most commonly accepted and offer best chances of recovery), food, water and medication for two weeks, and an airline approved carrier. Some evacuation shelters in our area now accept pets. Please ask our knowledgeable staff for more information including a brochure on this evacuation option.

Brandt Veterinary Clinic will also accept pets into our pet resort on a first come – first served basis if you cannot take your pet with you when you evacuate. Please be aware that our staff and doctors will also leave should we be ordered to evacuate. We are in evacuation zone B, which is wind velocity 96 to 100 mph, or storm surges to 15ft. Should this happen, we will make your pets as comfortable and safe as possible with food and water before we evacuate, and we will return as soon as we are allowed back into this area.
